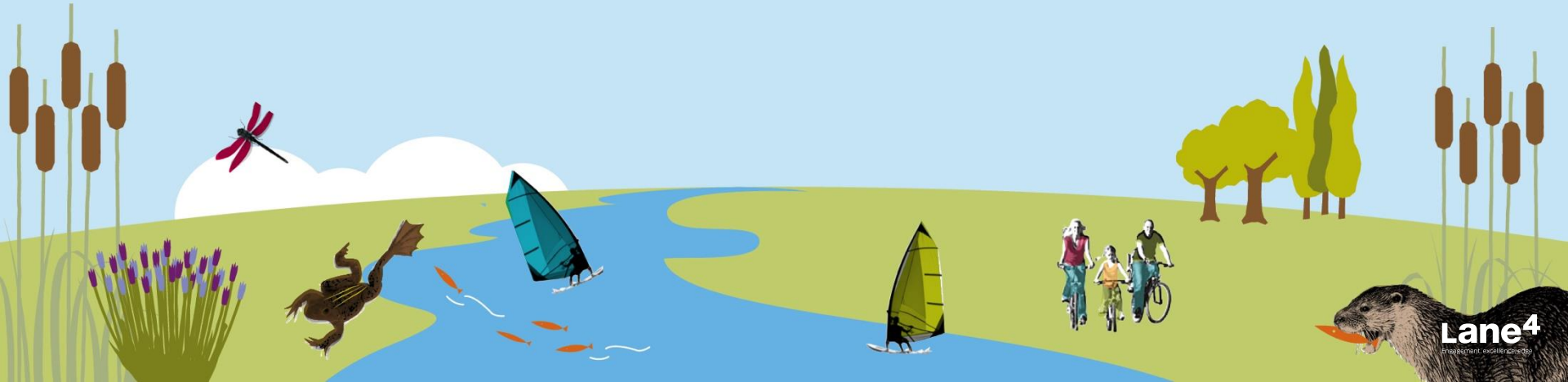

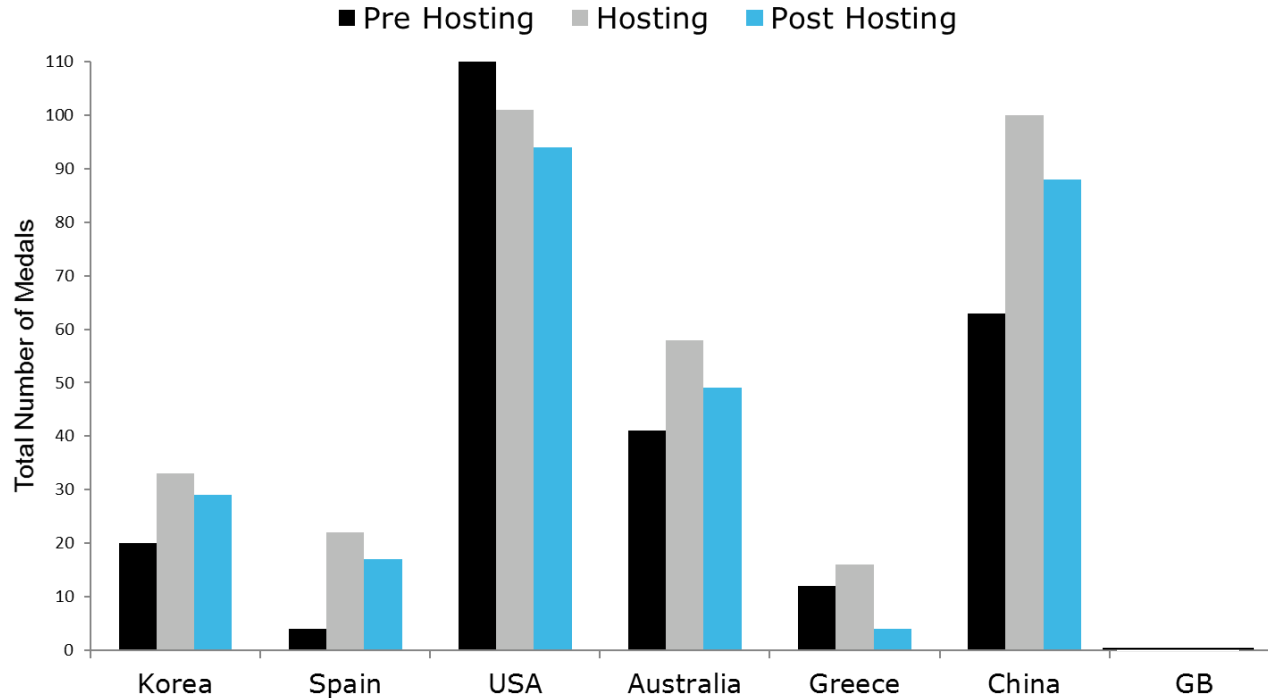

- Solutions to challenges identified, action plans under way with signs of progress being made

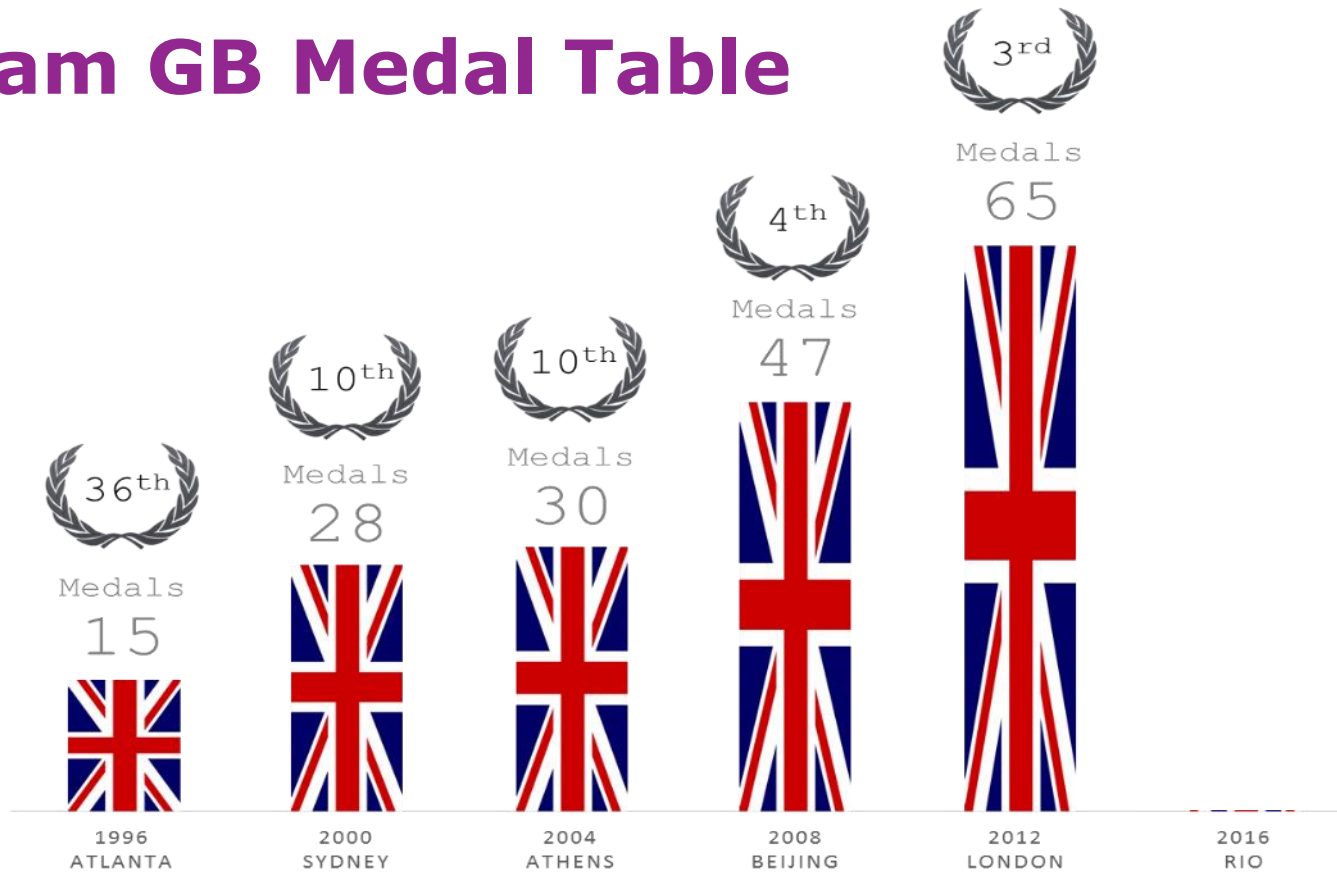
Red Need help

- Solutions to challenges not agreed, planned or activated

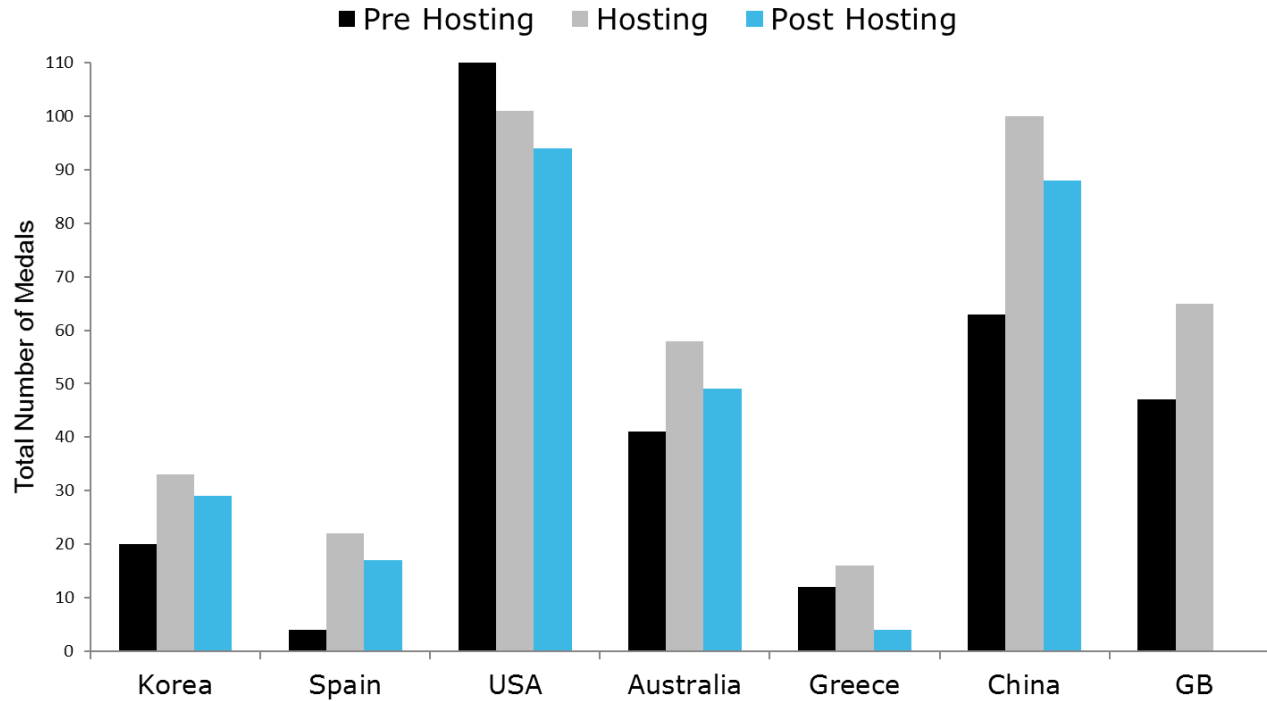
Gold Excelling
