1. The prize draw is open to residents in selected areas of Brandon and Ipswich in the county of Suffolk, United Kingdom, aged 16 years or over, except employees of the Promoter (see point 20), their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
2. The prize draw is free to enter but entrants must have completed the glass recycling survey.
3. All entries must be submitted via the prepaid envelope provided or via <https://www.surveymonkey.co.uk/r/glassrecyclingsuffolk> and only one entry per household. Alternatively, surveys completed during a certified household visit undertaken by individuals appointed by the Suffolk Waste Partnership.
4. The opening date for entries is 09.00 on 28th November 2017. The closing date of the prize draw is 23.59 on 15th December 2017. Entries received after this time will not be accepted.
5. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault [technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure] of any kind.
6. A winner will be chosen by random draw performed by a computer process from Monday 18th December.
7. One winner in each selected area will receive £50 of Love 2 Shop vouchers, which can be redeemed at the following retailers: <https://www.highstreetvouchers.com/gift/where-to-spend-love2shop-vouchers>
8. The winner will be notified by email or telephone (using details provided at entry) after Monday 18th December 2017. If a winner does not respond to the Promoter within 7 days of being notified, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.
9. The prize will be sent to the winner within 7 days of the tickets being received by the promoter from the ticket agent.

10. The prize for the winner is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
